

## PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to the Primary Election Law of the State of New Mexico, I Robyn Holmes, County Clerk, of the County of Otero, of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby issue the following Proclamation:

That a Primary election be and the same is hereby called to be, held throughout the County of Otero, State of New Mexico, and in each precinct thereof, on the 1st day of June, 2010;

That a Primary Election shall be applicable to the following political parties, to wit: The Democratic Party and the Republican Party; and

That the Primary Election shall be for the purpose of permitting the Democratic Party and the Republican Party to nominate candidates for the following offices:

Declaration of candidacy by pre-primary convention designation and nominating petitions for any statewide office or for the office of United States Representative shall be filed with the Secretary of State on Tuesday, February 09, 2010 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of retention of the two Justices of the Supreme Court and the two Judges of the Court of Appeals for the general election shall be filed with the Secretary of State on Tuesday, February 09, 2010 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of intent to be a write-in candidate in the primary election for the office of United States Representative, members of the

Legislature in multi-county districts, the public regulation commission, district judges, and public education commission, and any office voted on by all voters of the State shall be filed with the Secretary of State on Tuesday, March 09, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of intent to be a write-in candidate in the primary election for magistrates or members of the legislature located wholly within one county or composed of only one county shall be filed with the county clerk, on Tuesday, March 09, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of candidacy and nominating petitions for legislature, district judge, retention judges for all affected district judicial offices, public regulation commission, public education commission and all county offices shall be filed with the proper filing officer on Tuesday, March 16, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of candidacy and nominating petitions for magistrate judge shall be filed with the respective county clerk on Tuesday, March 16, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of candidacy and filing fees or, in lieu thereof, pauper statements for all other elective county offices shall be filed with the county

clerk on Tuesday, March 16, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of candidacy and nominating petitions for candidates who seek, but fail to receive pre-primary convention designation for a statewide office or the office of United States representative shall be filed with the Secretary of State during regular business hours either ten days following the date of the pre-primary convention or on Wednesday, March 31, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

No state convention for designating candidates shall be held later than Sunday, March 21, 2010.

Certificates of designation of primary election candidates shall be filed by political parties with the Secretary of State no later than 5:00 p.m. on the first Tuesday succeeding the state convention.
